Event Format

- The tournament takes place over **three days**:
 - **Day 1A – 7pm on Fri, Jan 23, 2026** (choose any host house)
 - **Day 1B – 7pm on Sat, Jan 24, 2026** (optional second attempt)
 - **Day 2 – 2pm on Sun, Jan 25, 2026** (Nomad's Poker Room)

Registration

- Registration opens at 12:00 PM for both Day 1A and Day 1B. Seating is first-come, first-served for each house.
- You may register at only one house for each Day 1.
- All houses will use www.blindvalet.com for the official tournament clock and registration. Use code XVTE to join the group.

Buy-In, Rebuys & Add-On

- \$60 for a full 50,000-chip starting stack.
- Up to 2 rebuys allowed per Day 1 flight you play
- Buy-ins and rebuys close at the second break
- At the second break, players may surrender their stack and re-enter with a full starting stack if they have not used both rebuys.
- \$40 add-on available during the second break for one full starting stack (50,000 chips).

Structure

- Blind levels are 20 minutes each.
- A 10-minute break occurs after every 60 minutes of play.
- Day 1A and 1B begin at level 1. Day 2 starts at the lowest blind level any day 1 ended at
- Each day 1 ends immediately once the field reaches 25% of the original players (rounded up) at each house. Those players advance to Day 2.
- Your end-of-day chip count is recorded and carried forward to Day 2.
- If you qualify on both Day 1A and Day 1B, only your largest stack advances to Day 2.
- Day 2 seating is randomly assigned.
- Tables play 8-handed until the final table, which runs 9-handed.

Prize Pool

- 100% of all buy ins, re-entries, and add ons are paid out to the winners
- Payouts are based on the total number of players across all Day 1 houses: 1 in 7 players will be paid (rounded down).
- Final payout amounts will be announced on Day 2.

General Rules

- Fair play and standard poker etiquette apply.
- All tables use dedicated dealers when available. If no dedicated dealer is available, players will take turns dealing.
- One player will shuffle, and a separate player must cut each deck of cards before hand is dealt.
